

Our stories: Coping in the age of COVID

Cara, single mom to three, strives to provide her children a stable, loving home. Her situation is unfortunately one we see too often: she receives no child support and the father does not make much effort to have a relationship with them, let alone provide care. With no other family nearby, Cara does not have a great support system, but is dedicated to raising her family the best she can.

Earlier this year, she secured a decent factory job, earning just enough to cover their necessities. Just two weeks into her new job, the factory closed as a direct result of COVID-19. It remains closed.

While remaining hopeful the factory would reopen, Cara searched for new employment, finally accepting a low-wage cashier position. She now earns just over \$300 a week to support her family of four. With the only other resource being \$330 a month in SNAP (food stamp) benefits, Cara's wages simply were not enough to maintain the most basic of household expenses.

It is both unthinkable and easy to imagine the difficult decisions Cara faced. Which

month should she pay rent, and which month electricity? SNAP benefits do not last all month, so if she paid both rent and utilities, how would she and her children eat? What if her kids needed clothing, or medication? Should she risk driving uninsured to make sure the water bill gets paid?

When Cara reached out to ADFAC for help, it was the first time she had ever requested our assistance. She was struggling to catch up on back rent and was also in arrears on



her electric and water accounts. During her phone interview, ADFAC's social worker could sense she was uncomfortable asking for help but could also tell Cara's priority was caring for her children. Thanks to grants received to help families affected by COVID-19, we were able to help with rent, electric, and fully pay Cara's water bill.

Cara was incredibly grateful and relieved for the much-needed financial aid. The short-term assistance also provided stability for Cara to seek higher-paying employment, which she hoped to secure before the holidays.

Since spring, ADFAC has provided 459 (and counting!) assistance actions for households that have been directly impacted by COVID-19. Like Cara, many lost their jobs and now work for lower wages. Others still have their pre-COVID jobs but are working fewer hours. Some have not been able to find employment at all. It is truly a stressful, challenging time for working-class families; many financially established households are also experiencing hardship.

From the very beginning of the pandemic, we have been impressed and heartened by the swift and generous response of our community. On behalf of Cara, her children, and all the other families we have been able to assist, **thank you.**

4,131 disadvantaged students receive backpacks and supplies

Good news is something we all need! Despite the challenges of operating during a pandemic, ADFAC's School Supplies Program was able to serve 4,131 preK-12 students in 2020! Challenges remain for 2021, but for today, we acknowledge the accomplishment and the difference it made for thousands of local students.
